Ordinance Serial No. 14-46(SUB)**

An ordinance of the Wasilla City Council amending Wasilla Municipal Code 10.20.020, Parking to Display Vehicle For Sale Prohibited and WMC 10.20.080, Remedies and Penalties, in regard to violations of this chapter.

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become part of the city code.

Section 2. Amendment of section. WMC 10.20.020, parking to display vehicle for sale prohibited, is hereby amended to read as follows:

No person may park a vehicle upon a street, roadway, right-of-way, city parking lot or other public property for the purpose of displaying the vehicle for sale. ~~A vehicle is parked for the purpose of displaying the vehicle for sale if the vehicle remains stationary at the same location for more than sixteen (16) hours, and there are one or more signs on or near the vehicle, visible from a street or roadway, communicating to passersby that the vehicle is offered for sale.~~

Section 3. Amendment of section. WMC 10.20.080, Remedies and penalties, is hereby amended to read as follows:

A. Remedies and penalties for violations of this chapter are as provided in Chapter 1.20.

B. Each act or omission in violations of this chapter, and each day in which the act or omission occurs, is a separate violation of this chapter.

C. All remedies for violations of this chapter are cumulative and are in addition to any other existing at law or in equity.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the Wasilla City Council.

Summary Statement: This ordinance amends WMC 10.20.020 by removing an exception for periods less than 16 hours. The administration is proposing to delete that portion of the code to prohibit parking and displaying vehicles for sale on public property and rights-of-way for any length of time. This is becoming a bigger problem on E. Sun Mountain Drive where the new Lithia dealer and Kendal Ford are parking and displaying vehicles in the right-of-way. This code change is needed to fully enforce a prohibition of using public property for the sale of vehicles.

Recommended Action: Adopt Ordinance Serial No. 14-46.
