Summary Statement: This ordinance is to correct the appropriation through Ordinance No. 14-06 adopted April 14, 2014. Ordinance No. 14-06 adopted capital improvement projects to include: a columbarium, road paving, sign, and fencing.

WMC Chapter 13.24 Wasilla Aurora Cemetery requires this fund to be an "irreducible fund" whereby the principal of the fund may not be spent other than that of any interest earnings. The earnings, if any shall be transferred to the General Fund and used exclusively for maintenance. operation of and capital improvement construction in the Cemetery.

It was the intent of Finance to appropriate as required by WMC and therefore requests consideration of Council to transfer appropriations previously adopted through Ordinance No.

14-06 to be appropriated in the Capital Improvement Project Fund. Additionally, any monies expended in FY2015 shall be transferred accordingly upon passage of Ordinance 14-43.

The transfer from the Capital Improvement Project Fund to the Cemetery Fund is to reimburse the fund for actual monies spent in FY2014.

Summary Statement: This ordinance amends the FY2014 budget by appropriating \$95,000 from the Cemetery Fund for capital improvements at the city cemetery as follows:

- 1) Columbarium Phase 1- this will provide the cemetery with its initial columbarium to support ongoing use of the cemetery as there are only 16 burial lots remaining for purchase. Proceeds from the sale of columbarium units will be set aside in the cemetery fund for additional phases of the columbarium.
- 2) Road Paving this will provide paving of the upper cemetery looped driveway to match paving previously completed in the lower section.
- 3) Sign & Fencing this will provide for a new sign at the entrance of the cemetery that will be more visible from Fishhook Road; and this will provide for new fencing along Aspen Avenue that is in a state of disrepair.
