Section 3. Appropriation.



SUMMARY STATEMENT: The Lions Club held a 50-50 raffle to benefit Youth Court. Tickets monies were to be split evenly with winning ticket holder and the Youth Court program. 620 tickets were sold by Youth Court members, City staff, and Lions Club members. Youth Court The winning ticket was drawn at the October 13th City Council meeting. The winner, Greta Van Susteren of Fox News in Washington DC, generously donated her winnings of \$620 to the Youth Court program. The Youth Court program received \$620 from the Lions Club as its split from the raffle.

These funds will be used to offset costs for student members and staff to attend the annual Alaska Youth Court Conference.
