SUMMARY STATEMENT: Resolution #08-34 allows for the authorization of a two-year, nine-month contract with the International Union of Operating Engineers Local 302. This contract adjusts the salaries of those employees of the City of Wasilla that are to be members of said union based on a step system. The total increase by fund of this adjustment which also includes benefits is as follows:

General Fund	\$15,097
Sewer Fund	16,967
Water Utility Fund	7,183
Airport Fund	1,424
Total All Funds:	<u>\$40,671</u>

The medical reimbursement health expense savings recognized by switching from Premera to Aetna will be used to fund these additional costs.

There are some items for which a financial impact cannot be accurately computed. Both the Human Resources and Finance Department staff will take on additional duties to manage the terms of the contract which could include overtime or the need for

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temporary help. The Shop Steward handling union business while on City time and the lost productivity is unable to be determined at this time. The two additional holidays could necessitate adjustments to schedules, work being delayed, overtime or temporary help which is unquantifiable at this time.

And, finally, the impact of the Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) in addition to the step increases for fiscal year 2010 is unable to be calculated until both the CPI-U for Anchorage is published and performance evaluations have been completed. The proposed FY10 budget allows for a merit increase of 5%. The step increases range from in the 3.3% to 4% and the COLA can go up to 4% per the contract.

RECOMMENDATION: Based on the premise that resolution #08-34 will be adopted and the contract with the union approved it is recommended to adopt Ordinance No. 08-45 that amends the FY2009 budget by transferring funds within the General Fund, the Sewer Fund, the Water Utility Fund and the Airport Fund from Fund Balance to the Personnel Services lines items referenced.
