

**Summary Statement:** Valley Performing Arts recently approached and informed the administration that they have been approved by The Foraker Group to seek guidance and technical assistance through their pre-development program to determine the feasibility of constructing a new facility. Through the pre-development program, Valley Performing Arts is proposing to consider three options for the development of a new facility in Wasilla to confirm the long-term viability of the organization and the community it serves. The three options are as follows:

- 1) Improve and expand the existing facility on Swanson Avenue.
- 2) Redevelop the old movie theater on Old Matanuska Road.
- Construct a new facility next to the Menard Center under a lease agreement with the City of Wasilla.

The administration believes all three options are viable as it keeps Valley Performing Arts in Wasilla. In addition, the administration believes a new location next to the Menard Center could provide opportunities to enhance the use of the Menard Center as the two facilities could help support each other with public events. If the third option proves to be viable through the predevelopment program, then the City Council would need to approve a lease to Valley Performing Arts in accordance with Wasilla Municipal Code 5.32.110.A.2 for a nonprofit organization authorized to carry out a public purpose on approximately 4-acres of Menard Center property.
