**City of Wasilla
Ordinance Serial No. 15-13**

An ordinance of the Wasilla City Council amending Wasilla Municipal Code 1.20.030, Disposition--Scheduled Offenses, in regard the fine schedule for the regulation of marijuana.

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become part of the city code.

Section 2. Amendment of subsection. WMC 1.20.030, Disposition of Scheduled Offenses—Fine Schedule, is hereby amended to update the fines for marijuana manufacturing as follows:

Code Section	Description of Offense	Fine
9.40.030(A)	Marijuana Manufacture - For Sale or Commercial Use	\$750 300
9.40.030(B)	Marijuana Manufacture - Using Volatile or Explosive Gas	\$750
9.40.040	Marijuana Transport	\$750 400
9.40.050	Marijuana Use	\$100
9.40.060	Marijuana Clubs Prohibited	\$1,000

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the Wasilla City Council.





Summary Statement: Please see attached Ordinance Serial No. 15-13, which updates the fine schedule in Chapter 1.20 of the City Code. After Ordinance Serial No. 15-10(AM) was adopted on March 23, 2015, we discovered that WMC 1.20.030, Disposition—Scheduled Offenses should also have been amended to give marijuana manufacturing two different categories in the fine schedule.

In reviewing this section further and after discussions with the Chief Belden, it is also recommended to increase the fine for transport of marijuana.

Staff Recommendation: Introduce and set for public hearing Ordinance Serial No. 15-13.
