Summary Statement: This resolution transfers funds within an accounting fund (Capital Improvement Fund) for the new city shop addition. The new shop building was completed last fall with insulation, heating and electrical work being completed. The next phase of this project is an addition for offices and restrooms. The project budget has reached a balance of \$1.856 with the installation of the foundation footing for the addition.

Additional funding is needed to keep work progressing through June 30, 2015 using in-house labor for the foundation work. The Townsite Restoration project has a balance of \$32,135 and the administration is proposing to transfer \$10,000 of this balance for the new city shop to complete the foundation stem wall on the addition. The proposed remainder of \$22,135 is sufficient to continue with planned improvements to the historic townsite.
