**Summary Statement:** The wage scales for non-union hourly and non-union salaried has been increased by 1.75% CPI plus step. The wage scales for Laborers' Local 341 employees has been increased by 1.75% CPI with a freeze on step increases. The wage scale for Engineers' Local 302 has been increased by 1.75% CPI plus 2% step increase. The City of Wasilla is currently in contract negotiations with Teamsters Local 959. Should contract negotiations extend beyond July 1, 2016; the City will freeze pay scales until the City is able to bring forth a resolution to consider a new contract with wage scales.
