A Resolution Of The Wasilla City Council Certifying The Results of the October 4, 2016, Regular Election.

WHEREAS, pursuant to WMC 4.28.100, the Canvass Board met October 5 through 7, 2016, to judge the validity of absentee by-mail, early, special needs, and questioned ballots cast by voters in the October 4, 2016, Regular City Election; and

WHEREAS, on October 7, 2016, the Canvass Board opened and tallied the accepted absentee by-mail, early, special needs, and questioned ballots; and

WHEREAS, the results of the accepted ballots were added to the ballot tabulation results of the regular ballots cast by voters at the polls on Election Day; and
