SUMMARY STATEMENT: According to the report of findings commissioned by the Wasilla City Council and prepared by the Denali Commission, three city employees, along with Mayor Keller, acted inappropriately in their assistance with the development of two parcels located adjacent to the Parks Highway in Wasilla. (IM No. 08-16)

I believe these individuals must be held accountable for their actions, as city residents and business owners of businesses located within city limits, are entitled to fair and equal treatment.

I recognize that the Council does not have the authority to remove employees, therefore, I purpose to direct staff to prepare resolutions censuring the behavior of the public works director, the economic development planner, and the former deputy administrator for their involvement in the development of two parcels located adjacent to the Parks Highway in Wasilla. These resolutions will be placed on the July 28, 2008, Regular Council Meeting agenda.

ACTION: To direct the clerk to prepare three resolutions, censuring the inappropriate behavior of the public works director, the economic development planner, and the former deputy administrator for their role in the development of two parcels located adjacent to the Parks Highway in Wasilla as described in the report of findings prepared by the Denali Law Group.
