
Summary Statement: This ordinance amends the Fiscal Year 2017 by appropriating \$1,500,000 from the general fund, fund balance to acquire the former Iditarod Elementary School Parcel for a future Police Station. The former elementary school parcel is Tract B, Iditarod-Wasilla Schools 2016 Subdivision recently created by the Mat-Su Borough. The Borough's appraisal information shows the land value at just over \$1 million. In addition, there is at least \$500,000 of existing improvements to the parcel that includes land clearing, excavation, driveway aprons, pavement, and utility extensions.

The proposed land acquisition for a Police Station is consistent the City's Budget Goals and Initiatives adopted by the City Council on January 9, 2017. More specifically, stated in initiative No. 23 to; Support, design and develop a relocation plan of the existing police facility and identify funding sources for relocation, pending architectural and engineering review. An architectural and engineering review was done for this site and old school building in 2016 that showed the site is suitable for the proposed public safety use. The old school building has been demolished, but the site remains in excellent condition for re-development.

Staff Recommendation: Introduce and set the ordinance for public hearing.



Matanuska-Susitna Borough Land Information Parcel Report






