**A Resolution Of The Wasilla City Council Certifying The Results Of The October 3, 2017, Regular Election.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to WMC 4.28.100, the Canvass Board met on October 4 and October 6, 2017, to judge the validity of absentee by-mail, early, special needs, and questioned ballots (ballots) cast by voters for the October 3, 2017, Regular City Election; and

WHEREAS, on October 6, 2017, the Canvass Board opened and tallied the accepted ballots; and

WHEREAS, the results of the accepted ballots were added to the ballot tabulation results of the regular ballots cast by voters at the polls on Election Day; and

WHEREAS, the results compiled by the Canvass Board are reflected in the attached Official Results spreadsheet, Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that we the Wasilla City Council certify, that the October 3, 2017, Regular Election was held valid to the best of our knowledge.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the results of the October 3, 2017, Regular Election are certified as follows:

1. Bert L. Cottle was elected to the office of Mayor, a three-year term ending October 2020, having received the greatest number of votes cast for Mayor.
2. Stephen M. "Mike" Dryden was elected to Council Seat A, a one-year term ending October 2018, having received the greatest number of votes cast for Seat A.

3. Stuart R. "Stu" Graham was elected to Council Seat C, a three-year term ending in October 2020, having received the greatest number of votes cast for Seat C.

4. Glenda Ledford was elected to Council Seat D, a three-year term ending in October 2020, having received the greatest number of votes cast for Seat D.

5. PROPOSITION W-1, Sales Tax Adjustment, Wasilla Police Department Facility Improvements, was adopted by the voters (Ordinance Serial No. 17-15 (AM)), having received the greatest number of votes cast.
