**Section 1. Classification.** This is a non-code ordinance.

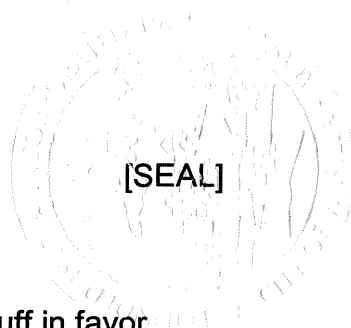
**Section 5. Effective date.** This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the Wasilla City Council.

**SUMMARY STATEMENT:** Acceptance and appropriation of funds in the amount of \$20,260 from the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities Highway Safety Office (AHSO) to be used for travel, training and equipping of two officers for the Motorcycle Traffic Enforcement and Safety program. AHSO will reimburse the City for travel, training, and the purchase of equipment for the two officers to attend Northwestern University's Police Motorcycle Operator Training and Certification National Academy being held in Allentown, PA. The program will expand the department's motorcycle traffic enforcement efforts, and the training focuses on the safe operation of motorcycles in a police patrol function.

Wasilla PD has a strong commitment to highway safety and enjoys a positive working relationship with the AHSO. The two newly trained officers will contribute to the department's traffic safety and enforcement efforts, especially during periods of heavy traffic flow.

**Staff Recommendation:**

Amend the FY09 police department budget to accept and appropriate funds from AHSO for the Motorcycle Traffic Enforcement program.
