Summary Statement: Pursuant to Wasilla Municipal Code (WMC) 2.08.090(D), Revisor of ordinances, the City Clerk reports the following editorial correction to WMC 5.16.100(D).

The voters ratified the adoption of Ordinance Serial No. 17-15(AM), at the October 3, 2017, Regular Election. The ordinance changed the City’s sales tax rate to three percent effective January 1, 2018. In preparing for the code change, we discovered that an amendment to WMC 5.16.100(D), should have been included in Ordinance Serial No. 17-15(AM). As such, the code has been corrected to read:

WMC 5.16.100(D)

When it is not feasible for the seller to show the sales tax on each transaction as a separate and distinct item, the seller may elect to remit to the city an amount equal to the seller’s gross receipts divided by 1.032 and multiplied by 0.032 in lieu of stating sales tax separately and adding it to the sales price. A seller makes this election for a calendar year by so indicating on its application for a city business license. A seller who has made this election shall include in each sign that displays prices to its customers a notice, in type no smaller than the type in which prices are displayed, stating, “All prices include 32% City of Wasilla sales tax.”
