Summary Statement:

The Library applied for \$5,000 from the Matanuska Electric Association, Inc. Charitable Foundation for the 2018 Summer Reading Program. Offered since 1979, Wasilla Public Library's Summer Reading Program is a multi-week motivational reading program for all ages, birth to adult, to read throughout the summer in order to maintain reading skills. Participants are rewarded for meeting reading goals with prizes, which makes this program fun and helps foster a love of reading. The grant from MEA Charitable Foundation will be used to provide special programs (past programs have included reptiles, puppet shows, yoga) that in to the Summer Reading Program theme, incentive prizes, the end of Summer Reading Program party, and to acquire supplies (materials for crafts, etc.) to have successful programs.

Last year's Summer Reading Program had over 1,200 participants and additional funding for this community event comes from the Friends of Wasilla Public Library, area businesses that donate funds, products and services, as well as donations from private individuals.
