Summary Statement: This project includes the installation of approximately 2,600 lineal feet of 8-inch diameter HDPE pipe, trail and road construction, and fencing associated with a treated effluent discharge pilot study at the Wasilla Wastewater Treatment Plant. The project was advertised through Invitation to Bid No. 0426-0-2018/AG with the following results:

The City's wastewater treatment plant currently uses a series of drainfields to discharge treated wastewater into the ground and water table.
