**A Resolution Of The Wasilla City Council Authorizing The Addition Of One Operator In Training Position For The Sewer Utility And Transferring Funding From The Wastewater Tech I In The Sewer Fund.**

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has not been able to fill a vacancy in the sewer utility for a Tech I position this year; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department is proposing to offer this vacancy at the entry level operator in training position to expand the pool of eligible candidates; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department is proposing this entry level position be used as a temporary measure until an operator in training can be promoted to the Wastewater Tech I position; and

WHEREAS, funding for the Operator in Training position will be through the adopted Biennial Budget for fiscal year 2019 from the authorized budgeted position of Wastewater Tech I.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Wasilla City Council authorizes the addition of one operator in training position as follows:


