**Section 3. Effective date.** This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the Wasilla City Council.

Summary Statement: Due to increasing difficulty in filling vacancies on the Airport Advisory Commission, Ordinance Serial No. 19-03 proposes to reduce the composition of the commission from seven members to five members making membership level with the Planning and Parks & Recreation Commissions. The reduction will result in an annual budget savings of \$600. The commission currently meets quarterly with members earning \$75 per meeting attended.
