

Summary Statement: This contract award is in response to the City's Invitation to Bid No. ITB-0603-0-2019/AG. This project removes approximately 500 feet of guardrail along Clapp Street and places fill material along the same section of road to provide a 4:1 foreslope. This section of guardrail has repeatedly been damaged by commercial truck traffic using the adjacent gravel pit. Providing a flatter foreslope next to the roadway allows for the guardrail to be removed and maintain a safe clear zone for vehicles. This project is funded by the remaining State of Alaska Legislative Grant for the Clapp Street Project. The following bids were received on June 20, 2019:
