An Ordinance Of The Wasilla City Council Amending The Fiscal Year 2020 Budget By Appropriating \$33,205 Within The State And Federal Asset Forfeiture Funds For Sitka Academy Training Of Three New Wasilla Police Department Officers.

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. To appropriate funds in the fiscal year 2020 budget for the purpose of paying tuition fees for three new officers with the Wasilla Police Department to attend the Sitka Law Enforcement Training Program. The tuition fees qualify to be expended against asset forfeiture funds and are being requested now to appropriate funds for this purpose.



Summary Statement: The Wasilla Police Department has three new police officers who are required to attend the Law Enforcement Training Program in order to become certified officers within the State of Alaska. This training qualifies to be expended against asset forfeiture funds and is being requested now to appropriate funds for this purpose.

The total cost for the three officers is \$37,232, with asset forfeiture funds covering \$33,205, the balance of \$4,027 will be covered through the FY2020 adopted operating budget of the Wasilla Police Department, Patrol Division (001-4230-420-50-82).
