A Resolution Of The Wasilla City Council Certifying The Results Of The October 1, 2019, Regular Election.

WHEREAS, pursuant to WMC 4.28.100, the Canvass Board met on October 2, 2019, to judge the validity of absentee by-mail, early, special needs, and questioned ballots (ballots) cast by voters at the October 1, 2019, Regular City Election; and

WHEREAS, on October 4, 2019, the Canvass Board opened and tallied the accepted ballots; and

WHEREAS, the results of the accepted ballots were added to the ballot tabulation results of the regular ballots cast by voters at the polls on Election Day; and

WHEREAS, the results compiled by the Canvass Board are reflected in the attached Official Results spreadsheet, Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that we, the Wasilla City Council certify, that the October 1, 2019, Regular Election was held valid to the best of our knowledge.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the results of the October 1, 2019, Regular Election are certified as follows:

1. Nikki Velock was elected to Council Seat E, a three-year term ending in October 2022, having received the greatest number of votes cast for Seat E.
2. James E. Harvey was elected to Council Seat F, a three-year term ending in October 2022, having received the greatest number of votes cast for Seat F.
