SUMMARY STATEMENT: Acceptance and appropriation of funds in the amount of \$54,200 received from the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities Highway Safety Office (AHSO) to be used for purchasing 20 Stalker Model #DSR2X Moving Radar Units to update and equip patrol vehicles with moving radar for Wasilla Police Department's Highway Enforcement and Safety program. AHSO will reimburse the City for purchase of twenty (20) Stalker Model #DSR2X moving radar units.

Wasilla PD has a strong commitment to highway safety and enjoys a positive working relationship with the AHSO.
