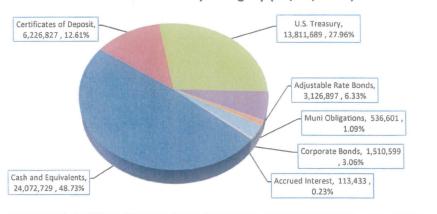

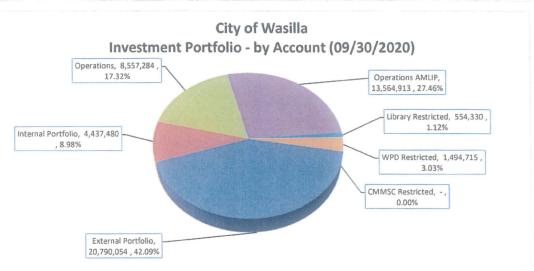

Due to staffing shortages and Covid-19 much of the last quarter was spent covering the sales tax position, Covid grant administration, as well as workflow and process changes related to the new Alaska Remote Sellers Sales Tax Commission (ARSSTC).

Per request, I have researched and tested an online option to hold sales tax classes remotely to reach more people during this time of social distancing and limited public contact. I hope to be able to organize and offer these classes soon.

As of September 2020, there were 352 accounts registered and collecting city sales tax with the ARSSTC, an increase of 209 since July 2020. Only 30 of them previous filers. As we transition to the MuniRevs software and through our renewal process for the upcoming year, I hope to identify businesses currently licensed with the City that should be migrated to the ARSSTC. Much of the next weeks/months will be devoted to this software transition, implementation, and training. The initial feedback we have received from businesses has been very positive.

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
