SUMMARY STATEMENT: At the August 10, 2009 Council meeting, AM No. 09-39 "Authorization to enter into a 3-year capital lease purchase option through MTA and Avaya Financial Services for the purposes of replacing the current telephone system" was adopted.

The Fund Balance within the Technology Replacement Fund has sufficient funds to cover this capital purchase through the 3-year term.

The annual lease payment will equal \$2,380.77 per month or \$28,569.24 per fiscal year. The FY2010 appropriation has been reduced by 2-months due to the actual beginning payment not anticipated to begin until September 2009.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Approve the adoption of Ordinance Serial No. 09-58 and support the budget necessary for the above mentioned capital purchase.
