WHEREAS, the City of Wasilla ("City") is currently under a declared state of emergency as a result of COVID-19 that warrants the modification and/or waiver of the signature-gathering requirement within the boundaries of Wasilla.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Wasilla City Council hereby requests and supports waiver or modification of all petition requirements enforced or required by the Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office while the City's declaration of emergency remains in effect.
