The location is at Bumpus's south approach to the current soccer fields. Here we will be adding 0.3 acres of clearing that is flagged on site on both sides of the gate. Trees will be cut and stacked with usable wood cut into max 20 foot sections. Limb and top \sim 4" or greater diameter trees. Limbs and tops will be placed in a pile for COW to chip. Stumps will be placed in another pile for COW to process.

Currently, COW crews have cleared the trail to approximately a 25' wide corridor and adding small ditches with about an 8 to 12-inch native base layer about 11 foot wide. Trail topping (E-1) ~1,000 tons will be placed 3-inches thick with a finish top of 10 foot wide. Straight sections will be crowned 3% for drainage off the trail center both ways unless in a curve and will not exceed 3% super. Compaction will be a compactive effort with a smaller vibratory roller.

Submittals required:

- 1) E-1 gradation
- 2) Scale's certification
- 3) Daily E-1 haul summaries

Traffic Control will be needed around work activities from the public and your staging area. COW will perform our own processing of the trees, limbs and stumps. Utilities are present and required to call in locates at 811. Work around all utilities.

Staging of equipment will be in the parking lot where you can use the existing gate. Work times will be from 7am-9pm Monday through Saturday.

Contract date will be awarded on August 10th. Contract completion date will be August 28th. Estimated contract amount less than \$50,000.
