**A Resolution Of The Wasilla Parks And Recreation Commission Recommending
Improvements To City Parks.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wasilla Municipal Code (WMC) 2.64.010(B), the purpose of the Wasilla Parks and Recreation Commission is to advise the City on matters pertaining to parks and recreation facilities; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Parks and Recreation Commission is to provide optimum service levels to the public as cost-effectively as possible, promote a healthy community, provide a safe environment and a quality lifestyle, and promote maximum citizen participation in government; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Commission recommends additions and improvements to the following parks:

- Iditapark:

- Trim the bottom of the spruce trees that are located by the pavilions for visibility and security.
- Extend the paved bike path on the Southwest corner of the park.
- Develop a dog park located by the Weber Street side of the park.
- Install security cameras for the amphitheater.
- Place a master sign showing the distance of the trails at the park with mile markers around the trail.
- Display sign boards for Wonderland Park.

- Newcomb Park:

- 33 ○ Upgrade restroom for the public.
- 34 ● Nunley Park:
 - 35 ○ Move the signs located by the wooded area closer to the parking lot.
 - 36 ○ Upgrade swings, and add more slides, a climbing structure with different
 - 37 levels.
 - 38 ○ Add evergreen bushes and trees along the fence line.
- 39 ● Lake Lucile Park:
 - 40 ○ Provide the ability to make reservations and payment online.
- 41 ● Carter Park:
 - 42 ○ Construct an ADA accessible path and viewing platform at the waterfront.

43 WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Commission recommends additions and
44 improvements to all city parks as follows:

- 45 ● Install security cameras to help with vandalism.
- 46 ● Install a disc golf course-location to be determined.
- 47 ● Provide online pavilion rentals and payments for city parks.
- 48 ● Charge \$20 for 4-hour block pavilion rental, and \$40 for an 8-hour block pavilion
- 49 rental.
- 50 ● Post a sign on pavilions with rental information regarding price and contact
- 51 information.
- 52 ● Develop land to connect Pedersen Park to Cottonwood Creek Park.
- 53 ● Conduct a parks community survey to find out the needs of the community.
- 54 ● Establish an adopt a park program.
- 55 ● Establish a community workday for all city parks.
- 56 ● Sell the naming rights for the pavilions at Iditapark and put the funds towards
- 57 recreation programs.

- Plant evergreen trees around city for year round beauty.
- Move forward with the Parkour park, but change of location to leave room for skate park expansion.
