Summary Statement: In January 2022, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough (MSB) suffered a severe windstorm which received a disaster declaration by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). The windstorm damaged MATCOM's light pole and privacy fencing. Required repairs to the fencing include removal and disposal of old fencing and installation of new privacy slat fencing. Repairs to two light poles includes replacement of the poles and heads, existing bases will be used.

The requested appropriation is based on Megawatt's bid for the light pole repairs and Mt McKinley Fence Company's estimate for fence repair. Due to the safety issues, the light poles are expected to be repaired in November. This ordinance would replenish the repairs and maintenance budget for this unplanned cost. The fence repair will occur next spring.

These necessary repairs were not budgeted in FY2023. The City will seek reimbursement of these costs as either a claim under its property insurance policy or as an eligible expenditure under the FEMA grant program.

Proposed Action: Introduce and set the Ordinance for public hearing. Approve.

- Remove and dispose of approximately 239LF of existing 8' brown privacy slat fencing.
- Furnish and install approximately 239LF of 8' brown privacy slat fencing.
 - One 5' wide walk gate

Total Contract Price: \$27,053.00

This price includes the following list of materials: 8' brown privacy slats, 1 5/8" x 40WT top rails, middle rails and bracing, 2 7/8" x 40WT line posts on 6' centers set in 4' of concrete, 4" x 40WT terminal posts set in 4' of concrete, 4" x 40WT gate posts set in 4' of concrete, steel twist ties to support fabric against high winds and 7ga bottom tension wire.

Exclusions: Staking, signs, locks, surveying, grading, clearing, permits, testing, bond, engineering, all electrical work, programming, traffic control/ flagging, utility locates, SWPPP, all dirt-work to include removal of spoils, grounding, asphalt / landscape / concrete repair, drilling in or excavation of boulders / bedrock and winter work.
