A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA PLANNING COMMISSION IN SUPPORT OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH'S REQUEST TO EXPEND GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA TO CONDUCT A BASE-LINE SURVEY OF HISTORIC SITES WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF WASILLA.

WHEREAS, Fran Seager-Boss, Cultural Resources Specialist with the Matanuska-Susitna Borough presented the project to the Wasilla City Council on November 23, 2009 and to the Wasilla Planning Commission on November 24, 2009;

WHEREAS, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough proposes to accept and appropriate \$24,562 from the State of Alaska, Department of Natural Resources, Office of History and Archaeology to fund 480, Project No. 20376 and approve the scope of work and budget to research and conduct a base line survey of historic sites and buildings within the boundaries of the City of Wasilla, Alaska;

WHEREAS, the survey will be conducted in partnership with the Wasilla-Knik Historical Society who will provide information regarding the history and the historic sites in Wasilla;

WHEREAS, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough will meet with interested owners of land and structures that have historical significance and arrange to photograph and describe their respective sites and structures; and

WHEREAS, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough's Cultural Resource staff will meet with the Wasilla-Knik Historical Society to discuss historic contexts represented by Wasilla's built environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Wasilla Planning Commission supports the Matanuska-Susitna Borough's proposal to create a base-line inventory of historic sites and buildings within the City of Wasilla; and
