

**WASILLA PLANNING COMMISSION
RESOLUTION SERIAL NO. 09-18**

A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA PLANNING COMMISSION ADOPTING AN INCREASED NOTIFICATION DISTANCE OF 2,500 FEET FOR THE OUTDOOR FIRING RANGE REMAND TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, The Wasilla Planning Commission requested that the notification distance be increased from 1,200 feet to 2,500 feet for the remand hearing of the Outdoor Firing Range decision, where the Planning Commission will consider three findings that the Hearing Officer found needed additional consideration by the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, in regard to increasing the notification distance the WMC 16.08.040 states,

“The commission may by resolution identify those parties that are to be included in the review of certain proposed actions under this title. These parties may include city departments, the school district, borough, state or federal agencies and private individuals or groups potentially affected or with interests in the proposed action. The reviewing parties will be provided all relevant materials and may submit comments and recommendations concerning the proposed actions. The comments of a reviewing party shall be given due deference during reviews of proposed uses by the planner or commission. (Prior code § 16.43.308) ”

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Wasilla Planning Commission finds that the notification distance shall be increased from 1,200 feet to 2,500 feet for the outdoor firing range remand hearing only.
