**AN ORDINANCE OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WASILLA TO AMEND THE FY10 BUDGET BY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM THE MULTI-JURISDICTION DRUG TASK FORCE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$91,652.91, WITH A CITY MATCH REQUIREMENT OF \$35,092.64, TOTALING \$126,745.55.**

WHEREAS, in the original FY10 expenditure budget \$114,943 was appropriated, thus requiring an increase of \$11,802.55 to equal the total award with the required match; and

WHEREAS, in the original FY10 budget \$80,000 has already been appropriated.

**Section 1. Classification.** This is non-code ordinance

**Section 2. Purpose.** To amend the FY10 Police Department budget by accepting and appropriating funds from the Multi-Jurisdiction Drug Task Force JAG grant to the Police Department's budget to cover small tools and equipment and gasoline expenditures for the Wasilla Police Officer assigned to the Multi-Jurisdiction Drug Task Force.
