WHEREAS, in 2009 multiple Proms were held on the same weekend and the same is planned for 2010; and

WHEREAS, having Prom held on the same weekend by multiple schools has caused undue hardship on local vendors; such as florists, hair stylists, tuxedo rental establishments, etc; and


WHEREAS, the Police Departments see an associated increase in service calls; and

WHEREAS, the communities as a whole will benefit if each high school holds Prom on a separate weekend.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Wasilla City Council hereby requests that the Matanuska-Susitna School Board coordinate Prom dates with local high schools which are more amenable for Prom goers as well as the community.
