SUMMARY STATEMENT: The Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation Opportunity Online Hardware Grant is a two year program is designed to help libraries sustain technology services and strengthen their capacity to conduct advocacy and secure local funding. This is the second year of the program, and Wasilla Meta-Rose Public Libraries has received \$1,300. The monies, as per the grant agreement, will be used to purchase one patron computer. Any remaining monies will be used for technology expenses; the one condition of the grant is that monies must be spent on technology to benefit the public.
