SUMMARY STATEMENT: This project was advertised on February 10, 2010 with a bid opening on March 3, 2010. The following bids were received:

This project will continue excavating apron space into a large hill along the north west section of the runway. This project will also establish a haul road over the hill and around the north end of the runway towards the Sports Center. The excavated material will be hauled for future apron space along the north east section of the runway. This project will be earth work only. This is part of a 3-year project to construct a paved apron area for 2 lease lots and 28 aircraft tie-down spaces. This project is being funded 95 percent by the Federal Aviation Administration.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Authorize the Mayor to execute a contract with Scarsella Brothers in the amount of \$994,814 for Wasilla Airport Apron D Phase 1 subject to the appropriation of the Capital Budget effective July 1, 2010.

D. GEOTECHNICAL INFORMATION
