RESOLUTION NO. W84-P-1

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO PLACE THE QUESTION OF FLUORIDE ON THE BALLOT AT THE REGULAR ELECTION OCTOBER 2, 1984.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to determine the feelings of its citizens on the question of fluoride to the City Water System through an advisory vote;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to place the following question on the October 2, 1984 Regular Election Ballot as Proposition No. 1.

"Shall the City of Wasilla continue to add fluoride to the public water system?"

Yes (a yes vote indicates that the voter approves of the addition of fluoride to the public water system.)

No (a no vote indicates that the voter does not wish to add any fluoride to the public water system.)

I certify that a resolution in substantially the above form was passed by a majority of those voting at a duly called and conducted meeting of the governing body of the City of Wasilla this 23rd day of July, 1984.
