A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO PLACE ON THE BALLOT AT A SPECIAL CITY ELECTION, THE FOLLOWING PROPOSITION: "SHALL THE CITY OF WASILLA BE RECLASSIFIED TO A FIRST CLASS CITY?"
