A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO PLACE ON THE BALLOT AT A SPECIAL CITY ELECTION TO BE HELD NOVEMBER 2, 1982, ON THE QUESTION OF IMPLEMENTING A POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, enabling legislation establishing a City Police Department has been passed by the Wasilla City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Wasilla City Council desires to determine the wishes of the voters on the establishment of a police Department;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to place the following proposition on the ballot at a special election to be held November 2, 1982.

"Shall the City of Wasilla implement its Police Department by initiating an "Academy Trained" Volunteer Police Force as presented in the following plan?"
