RESOLUTION NO. W87-T-2

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO PLACE A SALES TAX PROPOSITION ON THE BALLOT AT THE 1987 REGULAR ELECTION.

WHEREAS, a public safety department is needed in Wasilla; and

WHEREAS, funds are needed to establish a public safety department; and

WHEREAS, funds are needed to replace diminishing state and federal revenue; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to keep property taxes to a minimum; and

WHEREAS, revenue from a sales tax would fund a public safety department and other city services;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Wasilla City Council directs the City Clerk to place the following proposition on the ballot at the October 6, 1987 Regular Election:

"Shall the City of Wasilla institute a 2% sales tax to fund the nucleus of a Public Safety Department with the balance used to fund City operations?"
