**A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING AN ENERGY EFFICIENCY BLOCK GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000 FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY THROUGH THE AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT FOR A GEOTHERMAL HEAT PUMP SYSTEM AT THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT.**

WHEREAS, the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act has made Energy Efficiency Block Grants available to communities in Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wasilla is eligible for the Energy Efficiency Block Grant in the amount of \$50,000 based on the City's population; and

WHEREAS, the Energy Efficiency Block Grant is intended to reduce the use of fossil fuels in Alaska and across the country; and

WHEREAS, the Energy Efficiency Block Grant will be used for a geothermal heat pump system at the City's Wastewater Treatment Plant to supplement the existing natural gas heating system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Wasilla City Council accepts the Energy Efficiency Block Grant in the amount of \$50,000 for a geothermal heat pump system at the Wastewater Treatment Plant.
