CITY OF WASILLA ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 10-30

AN ORDINANCE OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING CHAPTER 9.24,

VANDALISM.

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent

nature and shall become part of the city code.

Section 2. Adoption of Chapter. WMC 9.24, Vandalism, is adopted to read as

follows:

9.24.010 Definitions.

When used in this chapter, the following words or phrases shall have the

meanings set forth in this section:

"Vandalism" means the intentional and malicious destruction, defacing of

or damage to property of another.

9.24.020 Vandalism.

A. It shall be unlawful for any person to intentionally commit any act of

vandalism to public or private property of another without the express permission

of the owner of such property.

B. Vandalism on any public or private property visible from any public

right-of-way, including but not limited to any street, highway, road, alley or

walkway, may be declared a public nuisance. The city shall give notice to the

property owner requesting the owner to remove or cause to be removed such

vandalism.

9.24.030 Parental civil liability.

Any act in violation of this chapter committed by a minor under the age of 18 years, shall be imputed to that minor's parent or legal guardian. A parent or legal guardian of a minor who violates this chapter shall be liable for the payment of any civil fine and the expense of restoration as provided by Chapter 1.20.

9.24.040 Remedies and penalties.

- A. Remedies and penalties for violations of this chapter are as provided in Chapter 1.20.
- B. Violators of this chapter shall repay the property owner or city the costs to restore the value of the property, including labor costs. Failure to comply with ordered removal or payment of costs shall create a cause of action that can be enforced in a civil suit.
- C. Any person who commits a violation of this chapter shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 for each violation.
- D. Any person, including the city, may seek appropriate injunctive relief for the enforcement of this chapter, its penalties and remedial provisions, including but not limited to actions for abatement, prevention of violations, and enforcement of all remedial and preventive provisions of this section as may be appropriate.

Section 3. Amendment of subsection. WMC 1.20.030.C, Disposition of scheduled offenses – Fine Schedule, is amended by adding a table entry for WMC 9.24.020, as follows:

Section 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the Wasilla City Council.
