AN ORDINANCE OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL AMENDING WMC 2.60.010(D) TO CLARIFY THE DURATION OF TERM LIMITS FOR PLANNING COMMISSIONERS.

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become part of the city code.

Section 2. Amendment of section. WMC 2.60.010(D), within Establishment, duties and compensation, is hereby amended to read as follows:

D. No person may serve on the planning commission for more than two consecutive, full terms without a break in service for at least one full year after serving two consecutive, full terms. [A PLANNING COMMISSIONER WHO HAS SERVED MORE THAN ONE-HALF OF A TERM IS CONSIDERED TO HAVE SERVED A FULL TERM.]

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the Wasilla City Council.
