ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 10-40

AN ORDINANCE OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL AMENDING WMC 2.12.020, FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE, BY CLARIFYING WHEN FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE STATEMENTS SHALL BE FILED BY CANDIDATES FOR ELECTED CITY OFFICE.

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become part of the city code.

Section 2. Amendment of section. WMC 2.12.020, financial disclosure, is amended to read as follows:

2.12.020 Financial disclosure.

A. Elected **officials** [OFFICERS] of the city shall comply with Alaska Statute 39.50 which requires a public official to file a **disclosure** statement of [HIS] financial and business interests.

B. Appointed officers of the city shall comply with Alaska Statute 39.50 which requires a public official to file a **disclosure** statement of [HIS OR HER] financial and business interests.

C. Candidates for **elected city office** [THE ELECTIVE OFFICES OF THE CITY] shall comply with Alaska Statute 39.50 which requires a candidate for public office to file a **disclosure** statement of [HIS OR HER] financial and business interests **at the time of filing a declaration of candidacy under WMC 4.12.030 or at the time of filing a letter of intent to be a write in candidate under WMC 4.12.045. The clerk shall not accept a declaration of candidacy or a letter of intent unless the**

candidate either files the disclosure statement or has one on file for the current calendar year.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the Wasilla City Council.
