SUMMARY STATEMENT: The administration believes transportation projects need to be the number one priority in seeking funding from the State Legislature in the upcoming legislative session. As such, the administration is proposing the following:

Main Street Couplet

\$ 5.000,000

Currently part of the 2010-2013 Alaska Statewide Transportation Improvement Program Revision 12 Incorporated. Total funds needs are \$18 million, seeking \$5 million in FY2012 for design and right-of-way acquisition.

Airport Access Road

\$3,100,000

This project will construct a new access road to the airport from the Curtis D. Menard Memorial Sports Center on South Mack Drive. This road will provide a more direct route to the airport and provide more opportunity for development around the airport. It will also provide direct access between airport and Sports Center (designated emergency shelter) in the event a disaster occurs and supplies are needed.

This project will construct a new access road between Parks Highway and Knik-Goose Bay Road. This project will provide a vitally needed north-south corridor that will reduce vehicle trips on the Parks Hwy and KGB Road which are both safety corridors. Total cost estimate is \$15,800,000 that includes realignment of Fairview Loop and Traffic signal at KGB Road (Phase 2).
