Title 16 - District Use Chart and Specific Approval Criteria

Letter from Day Care operator

**SUMMARY STATEMENT:** During review of a Use Permit for a day care business located in the Commercial zoning district, it was noted by staff that the specific approval criteria for a day care in Section 16.16.060(B) limits the business to 25 children for the Rural Residential (RR), Single-Family District (R-1), Residential District (R-2), and the Commercial zoning districts. Residential Multifamily (RM) is the only other zoning district that allows a day care business but that district is not subject to the 25 children limitation. **NOTE:** See attached excerpts from Section 16.20.020, District Use Chart, and Section 16.16.060, Specific Approval Criteria and letter of support from day care business owner.

This limitation on the number of children appears appropriate for the RR, R-1, and R-2 zoning districts, due to the potential negative impacts to residential neighborhoods from the additional noise and traffic generated by day care businesses. Restricting the number of children will help keep the impacts at a more compatible neighborhood scale. However, it does not appear appropriate or necessary for the Commercial zoning district, since this district is intended to allow more intense commercial uses that are currently required to provide appropriate buffering and screening between commercial business and any adjoining residential use.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:** Approve the adoption of Resolution Serial No. 11-05 amending the Wasilla Municipal Code to remove the limitation on number of children in day care facilities in Commercial zoning districts and to change the required review from a Use Permit to an Administrative Approval.

A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMENDING THAT THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL AMEND WMC 16.16.060, SPECIFIC APPROVAL CRITERIA, TO REMOVE THE LIMIT ON NUMBER OF CHILDREN PERMITTED IN A DAY CARE FACILITY IN THE COMMERCIAL ZONING DISTRICT; AND AMEND WMC 16.20.020, DISTRICT USE CHART, TO CHANGE THE REQUIRED REVIEW FROM A USE PERMIT TO AN ADMINISTRATIVE APPROVAL.

WHEREAS, the Planning Staff requested to amend WMC 16.16.060, Specific Approval Criteria, and WMC 16,20,020, District Use Chart; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing date and time was publicly advertised; and

WHEREAS, on March 8, 2011, the Wasilla Planning Commission held a public hearing on this request; and

WHEREAS, the Wasilla Planning Commission deliberated on this request taking into account the current provisions of the WMC; and

WHEREAS, after due consideration, the Wasilla Planning Commission determines that the proposed amendment is appropriate.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Wasilla Planning Commission hereby approves this resolution recommending that the City Council adopt the following revisions:

Amendment of section. WMC 16.16.060, Specific Approval Criteria, is hereby amended as follows:

#### 16.16.060 Specific approval criteria.

The following uses are subject to the preceding general criteria and these additional approval standards:

- B. Day Care. In the RR, R1, and R2 [and C] districts the following apply:
  - 1. A day care facility is limited to less than twenty-five (25) people.
  - 2. Play areas must be adequately screened and buffered from adjacent residential property.

**Amendment of section.** WMC 16.20.020, District Use Chart, is hereby amended as follows:

#### 16.20.020 District use chart.

A. The following chart summarizes the uses allowed and the standard of review for each use. In the commercial and industrial districts, more than one building housing a permissible principal use may be erected on a single lot, provided that each building and use shall comply with all applicable requirements of this chapter and other borough, state or federal regulations.

**SUMMARY STATEMENT:** Over the past year or so, staff has worked with USKH to update/revise the 1996 City of Wasilla Comprehensive Plan. Numerous public workshops and meetings were held to obtain input from the residents, City Council, Planning Commission, City staff, and other interested parties. The final draft of the proposed 2011 City of Wasilla Comprehensive Plan ("Plan") is attached for the Commission's review and consideration.

This Plan is a compilation of the input received from at the public workshops and meetings and includes goals, objectives, and actions for five categories — Transportation, Land Use, Downtown, Community Assets, Economic Vitality, and Intergovernmental Coordination. Listed below is a brief description of the purpose for the goals, objectives, and actions:

<u>Goals</u> are a broad statement of a future condition, desirable for the community.

<u>Objectives</u> are specific statements of desired results that help fulfill the goal.

<u>Actions</u> are the activities, programs and projects that should be undertaken, continued or modified to help achieve the established objectives and contribute to the fulfillment of the goals.

Once adopted, the Plan will provide a cohesive vision for decision-making specific to the City, based on its unique challenges and opportunities and will also serve as a road map for ensuring cost-effective City investment that is well-timed and coordinated to meet future growth needs. It will also serve as the legal foundation for the City's Land Development Code, help justify investments in capital improvements and municipal systems development, help bring residents together around future planning efforts, and be useful in securing grant funding and partnerships.
