AN ORDINANCE OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE FY11 POLICE DEPARTMENT BUDGET BY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM THE ALASKA HIGHWAY SAFETY OFFICE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,861 FOR THE PROBLEM-ORIENTED POLICING AND CRIME ANALYSIS GRANT.
