## CITY OF WASILLA ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 11-41

AN ORDINANCE OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL AMENDING WMC 12.04, STREET CLASSIFICATION AND DESIGN STANDARDS, TO REVISE THE STREET CLASSIFICATIONS AND DESIGN STANDARDS FOR STREETS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS.

**Section 1.** Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become part of the city code.

**Section 2. Amendment of section.** WMC 12.040.040, Right-of-way width, is hereby amended to read as follows:

A. The right-of-way width standards described **below** [HEREIN] are intended to serve as guides for obtaining and preserving rights-of-way:[.]

7.	Major arterial	100 feet
<u>6.</u>	Minor arterial	100 feet
<u>5</u> [E].	Major collector	100 feet
<u><b>4</b></u> [D].	Minor collector	100 feet
<u>3</u> [C].	Commercial	60 feet
<u><b>2</b></u> [B].	Local/residential	60 feet
<b>1</b> [A].	Low density [LOCAL/RESIDENTIAL]	60 feet

**Section 3. Amendment of section.** WMC 12.04.050, Traffic way width, is hereby amended as follows:

A. The minimum traffic way width for surfacing and graded shoulders of city streets are indicated below. Graded shoulder width is measured from the edge of the traveled surface or pavement to the beginning of the shoulder slope:

7.	Major arterial	Surface – 24 feet; Shoulder 4-8 feet
<u>6.</u>	Minor arterial	Surface – 24 feet; Shoulder 4-8 feet
<u>5</u> [E].	Major collector	Surface – 24 feet; Shoulder – <u>2-</u> 4[8] feet
<u><b>4</b></u> [D].	Minor collector	Surface - <u>22-</u> 24 feet; Shoulder - <u>2-</u> 4[-8] feet
<u><b>3</b></u> [C].	**Commercial	Surface – <u><b>22-24</b></u> [28] feet; Shoulder – <u><b>2-</b></u> 4 feet**
<u><b>2</b></u> [B].	Local/residential	Surface – 20 <u>-22</u> feet; Shoulder – <u>0-2</u> [4] feet
<b>1</b> [A].	Low density	Surface – 20 feet; shoulder – none

<sup>\*\*</sup>Commercial streets shall be paved.

**Section 4. Effective date.** This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the Wasilla City Council.

SUMMARY STATEMENT: The Street Classification section of the Wasilla Municipal Code is proposed to be amended at this time due to the Mat-Su Borough's road extension project of Machen Road into the City limits. This road is designed with 11 foot lanes and a pathway, however the WMC does not recognize a 22 foot roadway for any application. The proposed amendments allow for flexibility in road way design for this project and future projects. This information was presented to the Planning Commission on October 25, 2011, and the Planning Commission recommended by Resolution that the Street Classification amendments be adopted by the City Council.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt Ordinance Serial No. 11-41 amending WMC 12.04, Street Classification and Design Standards to revise the street classifications and design standards for streets within the city limits.
