

**SUMMARY STATEMENT:** This resolution is part of the administration's annual effort to secure federal funding for City capital projects. The Planning Commission adopted Resolution Serial N0. 11-20 in support of the following capital projects in accordance with WMC 2.60(A):

Main Street Couplet New Appropriation \$20 million

This is funding to support the Alaska Department of Transportation's effort to construct the Main Street couplet.

Main Street Couplet Reappropriation \$4.3 million

This is the redirection of funding previously earmarked to the City for projects that are no longer eligible for federal funding.

New Library \$7 million

This is 50 percent match funding for a new public library to be located at the corner of Swanson Avenue and Crusey Street. Total project cost is \$14 million for a 24,000 square foot facility.

Land Water Conservation Fund

\$10 million

This is funding to acquire land on Wasilla Lake for a public park and public lake access.
