**SUMMARY STATEMENT:** The Public Works Department is requesting additional funding for road maintenance through the end of the fiscal year due to above average snow fall this winter affecting the road maintenance budget. Specifically, funding for the City's on-call Equipment Contract is expected to be out of funding in March. A \$50,000 on-call equipment contract amendment is needed in March to meet projected expenditures through June. \$20,000 is currently available in the roads budget for this contract amendment. This ordinance will provide the balance of the funding needed for the contract amendment.
