SUMMARY STATEMENT: The City issued a Request for Proposal on March 30, 2012 for this project seeking qualified vactor truck operators to perform hydro excavating a small portion of the bottom of Lake Lucile to help induce groundwater flow from springs along the north-east end of the lake. This is a demonstration project to be performed between May 15 and July 15, 2012 in accordance with a Fish & Game Permit. The RFP was based on 50 percent experience and 50 percent pricing, and one proposal was received. The contract will be based on time and materials and evaluated daily to determine effectiveness. A vactor truck will be parked along the shoreline and a boat or platform will be used out on the lake, with up to 300 feet of suction line from the truck.
