A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF WASILLA, ALASKA SUPPORTING THE WASILLA-FISHHOOK ROAD, GLENWOOD DRIVE TO SCHROCK ROAD PROJECT NO. RS-0525(9)/53150 AND THE EXTENSION OF THE PALMER/WASILLA HIGHWAY.

WHEREAS, the transportation corridors in and around Wasilla, Alaska have become inadequate because of vastly increased volumes of traffic; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities has developed projects to improve the Wasilla area transportation routes; and

WHEREAS, the Wasilla City Council and members of the community have attended public meetings and made comments on the proposed projects; and

WHEREAS, the department has responded to public concerns and made acceptable revisions to their project plans.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Wasilla City Council supports the proposed dified Main Street/Knik Street couplet alternative for the Glenwood Drive to Schrock Road grade project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Wasilla City Council supports the extension of the Palmer-Wasilla Highway to Knik-Goose Bay Road at Glenwood with signalization and requests that the environmental assessment for this project be performed with the Glenwood to Schrock project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Wasilla City Council urges the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to proceed on the foregoing projects.
